

# Portable Start Lights

Portable Start Light's are user friendly motorsport start lights that work to a similar pattern that has been successfully used for a number of years in the World Rally Championship. They are New Zealand designed, and have been developed over the last five years for car club usage and do not take long for competitors to get used to.

Portable Start Lights are perfect for,

- ▶ Rallies
- ▶ Rallysprints,
- ▶ Hillclimbs,
- ▶ Motorkhana,
- ▶ Autocross

The lights are both robust and reliable. They are built to a high standard with the use of top quality parts. This allows the equipment to last longer and handle consistent repetitive use in less than ideal conditions which is often the case with car club events.

- ▶ Less volunteers needed at an event,
- ▶ Start and finish line is less hazardous for volunteers,
- ▶ More accurate and efficient. Less chance of human error.

- ▶ Start light control box,
- ▶ Jump start beam,
- ▶ Finish beam,
- ▶ Finish beam control box.

The package also comes with tripods, cables and the connectors needed to run the system

The complete package provides all timing equipment for hillclimbs and rallysprints, which can be used as two separate systems for Motorkhanas and Autocrosses.

The equipment is made with electrical components that are proven in industry world wide. We have adapted this equipment to provide a useful system designed for car clubs.



The timing is to 0.1 seconds. Equipment can have the clocks synchronised the day before the event, and in many cases a simple check will ensure that they are still synchronised and no adjustment will be needed. This minimises the work needed to get the event up and running in the morning of the event.

The equipment is simple to operate for anyone that has done timing for an event of any size.

The equipment can be used at all levels of car club events and will pay for itself in terms of accurate results, and more importantly enabling volunteers to do there jobs safer. There is no longer a need for someone to stand next to a car and do a manual countdown at the start, and the finish crews can be located in a position up to fifty meters away in a safe place away from the road.

Four sets of the equipment can be made at a much reduced price. The aim is to get the equipment out to the car clubs and for it to be used.

A full training DVD will be supplied with the equipment along with detailed operating instructions.
