**Acceptance of Entry – CARS and QUADS**

**Supplementary Regulations – Part Two**

We are pleased to advise that your entry for this event has been accepted. Your **competition number** is shown on the accompanying Start Order sheet. Please check this and ensure that your Class is correct.

**Documentation and Scrutineering** is at the Sheep No. 63 Café, State Highway 2, Woodville between 9.30am and 11.00am on Saturday, 27 February 2010.

Quad competitors please present your Motorcycle NZ licence and Club Membership card to the Documentation Secretary for checking. These and your vehicle log books will be retained for checking by your Steward.

**Breakfast / coffee will be available.**

**No late documentation will be permitted.**

**Drivers' Briefing** will be held on Saturday, 27 February at 12.15pm **adjacent to the HQ Caravan at the venue Start Line (Whariti Road)**. A Roll Call will be taken – this includes cars and quads. You must attend. A further roll call and verbal briefing will be held at the same venue on Sunday morning at 9.00am

**Start Order** – on Saturday, 27 February - Car No 1 will be starting at 12.30pm and all competitors will run in order of Seeding. Cars then Quads. If you are not in order your run will be forfeited. This is to ensure that everyone gets the maximum number of runs, and also if you happen to go “off” you can be found much quicker because we will be looking for you to pass each marshal point in your appointed order.

**Service Park** – Weather permitting, the Service Park will be in the paddock (on the left hand side) adjacent to the Start Line. A gold coin donation is required. If wet then Bushmill Road will be a Service Park – **the maximum speed is 30kph**. Please park on the Left Hand side of the road only. Parking is always at a premium – so please do not take more space than you really need.

Please note the following changes from the original Supplementary Regulations.

**Supplementary Regulations - Part One**

- 2. Major Officials** - Murray Starnes has been appointed Clerk of Course for Quads, Rod Bracegirdle will be an Assistant Clerk of Course for Cars.
- 3.3 Co-Driver/Passenger.** All cars are required to carry a co-driver or passenger. The Driver must ensure that their passenger is fully aware of the safety requirements. The Co-Driver/Passenger is required to sign an Indemnity form for each car that they may be a passenger in. If you do not change your passenger then only one signature is

required, but if you, as a passenger, change cars you must sign the Indemnity form for each car. The minimum age of a passenger is 12 years with parent or guardian consent.

**5.4 (a)** As the number of entries is less than anticipated, the number of runs for each competitor may be increased. You may wish to bring more fuel with you.

**5.5 Best run** – the best time from any of the runs count for the Class and Overall placings.

## **10. DAMAGE**

**All competitors – cars and quads**– please be aware that if you cause any damage to property, fences, bridges, power poles and such like, you will be liable for the cost of repairs to same. The total cost that you can be charged for is up to the “excess” of the MotorSport NZ Insurance policy. Please report your damage to the Clerk of Course. Remember it is an offence not to report any damage that you may have caused
